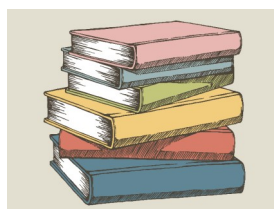


## Lunchtime Activities

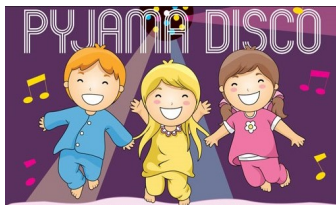
