

DIRECT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN REGARDS TO CORONAVIRUS

Information and advice for early learning centres, schools and universities.

An outbreak of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) was detected in Wuhan, China in late December 2019. Cases have been reported predominantly in the city of Wuhan, in the Hubei province of China, as well as other Chinese cities and countries, including confirmed cases in Victoria, Australia.

In accordance with national public health guidelines and current information about coronavirus disease from the Commonwealth Chief Medical Officer the department is now advising all people who have visited mainland China, returning to Australia from 1 February 2020 to stay at home and avoid public settings, including early learning centres, schools and universities, until 14 days after leaving mainland China. 
EASTER BUNRAISER

Step 3: Choose the package that best suits your needs (all orders will be returned to the school for collection)


