2021 booklist have been sent home today. The forms are due back in by next Friday at the latest but payment is not due until book pick up day next year so please don't stress, just get the order form back to us.

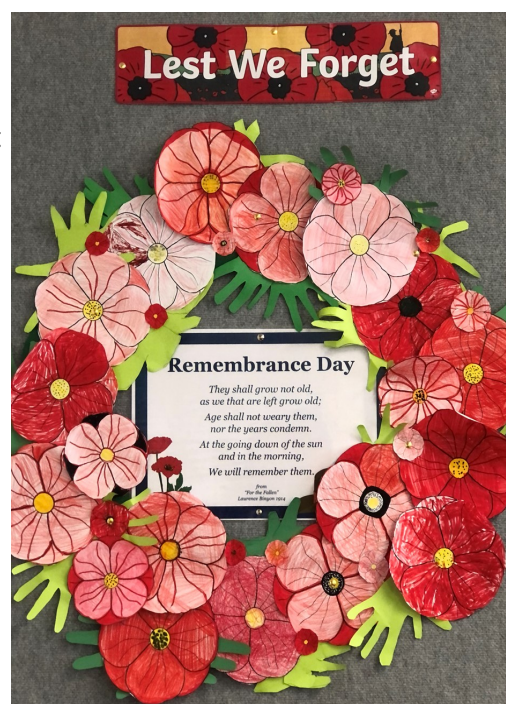
We had the most beautiful whole school zoom Remembrance Day service run by our captains yesterday. We were all so incredibly proud of all of our students and the respect that they showed during the service.

created by 1/2D

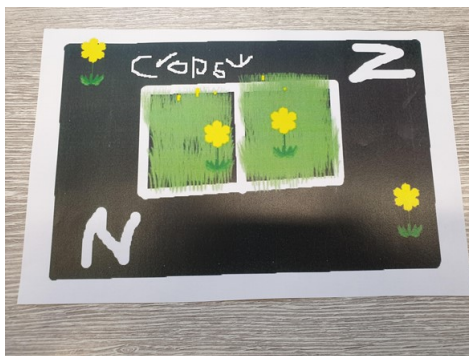

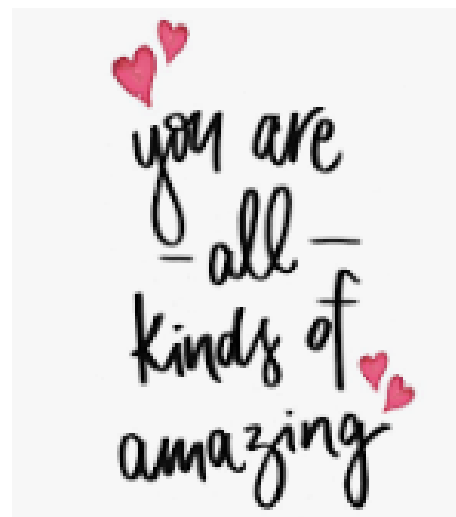
