Dress Code Appendix

It is a school policy that all students are required to wear school uniform, which comprises:

Lower Garments:

- ✓ Shorts- Navy
- ✓ Tracksuit pants- Navy
- ✓ Long Cotton Pants- Navy
- ✓ Trousers flared – Navy
- ✓ Polo shirt- Burgundy (Long Sleeve and Short Sleeve)
- ✓ Skorts- Navy
- ✓ Leggings - Navy
- ✓ Pleated skirt / Tunic- Navy
- ✓ Dress Checked Cotton- School colours

Upper Garments:

- ✓ School Polo Shirt (long or short sleeve)
- ✓ Vest- Navy
- ✓ Bomber jacket- Navy / burgundy stripes
- ✓ Windcheater- Navy - school logo only *
- ✓ Spray jacket- Navy

Other:

- ✓ Shoes- no thongs, Crocs or open-toed sandals permitted.
- ✓ Broad-brimmed Hats- Navy/school hats; worn from mid-August to 30 April
- ✓ Beanies- Navy with school logo only; worn in Terms 2 & 3 optional * (iron on school logos are available at the school office)
- ✓ Students may wear small plain stud or sleeper earrings (one per ear), a wristwatch, and medical alert jewellery. All other jewellery should not be worn to school for safety reasons.
- ✓ Clear nail polish only (no fake nails)
- ✓ Cosmetics (including fake eyelashes) may not be worn at school.

- ✓ Additional uniform items for Years 5 & 6 Senior School Rugby top and Year 6 jumper are available as a separate purchases. Year 6 polo shirts are a separate once only order usually taken in the year prior to entering Year 6.

Please note as per the School Council Uniform Policy, if students have a non-uniform jacket, we ask that they wear it to school, remove it for the day and then wear it home. Our Uniform Policy includes a warm bomber jacket. If students still require additional warmth, they are asked to please wear a plain navy jacket/coat/parka.
