5Cs of e-learning



Care

When I use digital technologies I will:

- * look after myself and others by thinking about what I share online
- * only use sites that are right for my age
- * turn off the screen or use the back button if I see something I don't like and tell a trusted adult.



Consideration

When I use digital technologies I will:

- * never share my or my friends' full names, birthdays, school names, addresses or phone numbers because this is personal information
- * stop to think about what I post or share online
- * speak to a trusted adult if I see something that makes me feel upset
- * if I need help I will speak to a trusted adult if I know someone else is upset or scared.



Co-operation

When I use digital technologies I will:

- * never copy someone else's work or ideas from the internet and present them as my own
- * be careful with the equipment I use



Communication

When I use digital technologies I will:

- * communicate respectfully by thinking and checking that what I write or post is polite and respectful
- * do not use actions online to be mean to others. (including leaving someone out to make them feel bad)
- * never send mean or bullying messages or pass them on, as this makes me part of the bullying.



Common Sense

When I use digital technologies I will:

- * protect personal information by being aware that my passwords, full name, photo, birthday, address or phone number is personal information and not to be shared
- * never answer questions online that ask for my personal information
- * only join a space online with my parent or teacher's guidance and permission
- * not deliberately search for something rude or violent
